
NSW OYSTER INDUSTRY STRATEGY





NSW Oyster Industry Strategic Plan

Summary

This report provides a summary of key initiatives and activities that are ongoing actions aligned to the priorities of the NSW Oyster Industry Strategic Plan 2015.

1. Delivering Strategic Priorities

The Plan identified five themes where there was potential for considerable gains to be made by the NSW oyster industry. These areas are described below.

3.1. Theme Area: Production Systems

Outcomes Sought:

- Resilient production systems
- Consistent cost-effective product
- Consistent access to high quality oyster seed stock

Priority Action:

- 1. Increasing adoption by industry of technologies & practices
- 2. On-going targeted R&D to provide a pipeline of innovation
- 3. The breeding-hatchery-nursery system is commercially viable
