


### **Port Stephens Estuary Clean-Up**



# Why should I care what the public thinks?

- Waterway is publicly owned
- Everyone is a stakeholder
- Aquaculture needs to be recognised as an appropriate use of public waterways
  - √ Government support
  - ✓ Community support
- Critical to develop new areas & scaleup production





## What is social licence to operate?

Social licence = Community granting you the freedom to operate with minimal formal regulations. <u>ALL ABOUT TRUST</u>

What is social licence to operate?



- Complaints
- Greater compliance & regulation
- Rigid, bureaucratic structure
- Higher costs

- Freedom to operate, minimal formal regulation
- Flexible, responsive structure
- Lower costs
